Unit Description

This unit takes evidence- and experience-based approach to course delivery, review, and quality improvement in higher and professional education. Current theory and best practice in learning and teaching inform an investigation of the science of learning, learner engagement, learning-centred and reflective teaching practice, and technology-enhanced course delivery and review. Unit assessments are designed to connect unit concepts and content with the experience and goals of individual learners.
