

HEP809 Learning in Professional Contexts

Unit Description

This unit aims to provide the learner with a rigorous and practical guide to learning and development in professional contexts. Key theories, research, and other resources particularly related to the technical design and delivery of learning and development opportunities will be explored in depth. The unit aims to illustrate how the ideas discussed are applied in practice, including experiences and "lessons learned" by learning and development professionals. The unit provides engaging activities to provoke critical reflection, to encourage the analysis of contemporary professional development concepts and case studies, and to apply that learning to their own professional context and that of others.
