

## HEP906 Engaged Research Project

### Unit Description

The aim of this unit is to provide students with the opportunity to build on the research proposal submitted in HEP903 to create a defined piece of independent research or to independently develop an artefact that further fosters the development of high-order eLearning knowledge and skills.

There is no conventional content in this unit as such. Instead, it caps the course off with a creative endeavour in which students develop a research project, a course, a unit or similar. It must of course relate to eLearning.

The unit will also enable students to demonstrate their capability in writing high-level research and development results. The students should also demonstrate mastery of time-management and the presentation of research and development outcomes.

<b>Credit Points</b>	24 credit points
<b>Duration</b>	12 weeks (10 teaching weeks and 2 revision and assessment weeks)

### Unit Learning Outcomes

On successful completion of this unit, students will be able to:

1. Create a defined piece of independent research or develop an artefact that relates to eLearning, based on a research and development design.
2. Write high-level research and development progress reports.
3. Manage their time, balancing competing commitments and meeting task deadlines.
4. Devise a means of effectively presenting research and development outcomes to stakeholders.
